

## REPORTS INJURING COUNTRY

The Yellow Fever Scare Noised Abroad is Wholly Without Foundation. Davis, I. T. Sept. 8.—(Special)—Rumors are flying thick and fast and reports of every kind and description about yellow fever cases breaking out all over the Indian Territory can be heard on the streets today. Doctors are reaping a harvest from the sale of health certificates, and traveling salesmen are complaining about what they consider a "hold up." These health certificates are not required, they say, and without them it is difficult to get around from town to town in the Territory.

Diligent inquiry reveals the fact that there are no cases of yellow fever in the Indian Territory, although eminent physicians are on the hunt for them. Experts from Texas and Washington have been at Mayaville during the last three days but they have failed to find any cases of yellow fever.

Business men here and elsewhere in the Wasita Valley are growing tired of alarmists, and unless something definite and reliable can be known very soon the country will be suffering untold damage.

One can hear any kind of a story imaginable. Men will talk as if a thousand cases of yellow fever existed in the Indian Territory, and give names of doctors who will verify their story. Investigation proves these reports to be erroneous and unfounded.

## Quarantine Raised.

Since the report of health officer Loving of Austin, Texas that there are no symptoms of yellow fever at Mayaville, the quarantines against that town by Pauls Valley and Chickasha have been raised.

A large quantity of advertising matter of the Ardmore Fair Association is being distributed over the country. Handsome lithographs of the coming fair, adorn the windows of the stores. The fair will be extensively advertised and hundreds of visitors are expected to be in attendance next month.


