FAMILY PERISH IN RIVER.

Mother and Two Children Lost While Crossing River During Storm.
Santa Fe, N. M., Oct. 24.—It has just been learned here that Senora Gundupha Vigil Barre, wife of a rancher at Round Mountain, and her two children lost their lives Monday as the direct result of the terrific blizzard that raged at that time. All three were drowned in the Rio Grande river, near San Ildefonso, Pueblo, two miles north of Santa Fe. While fording the river the animals became frightened at the depth and coldness of the water and the blinding snow storm, and becoming uncontrollable overturned the wagon.

Senora Barre's body was recovered immediately after the accident, but the bodies of the two children were carried down the stream and probably will never be found.

Army Scandal at Fort Sill.
Lawton, Okla., Oct. 24.—Two soldiers of the 13th cavalry have been sentenced to 20 years imprisonment after telling the story of their escapade with a woman whose name is known the nation over.

Private Lewis and Francis, of troop K, were before a court martial of officers here Saturday. To save themselves, they told what they claimed was the true and whole story of their relations with the woman. They were at once ordered dishonorably discharged and sent to the military prison.

The woman is married, has figured in social circles in Washington, and is related to a United States senator, one of the best known politicians in the country.

The two soldiers pleaded guilty, and no evidence was received save their own confessions.
