### Bold Robberies at Denison.

Denison, Texas, Nov. 20.—At 10:20 union station shortly before 2 o'clock this morning, while scores of people were waiting for trains, two of the boldest robberies ever perpetrated in Denison were committed and a short time afterward three persons, charged with the acts, were in the clutches of the law.

J. W. Matthews, a citizen of Lusk, Texas, was relieved of a pocketbook containing about \$5, and a grip was taken from H. J. Roberts of Durant, I. T.

Matthews was accosted by three men just outside the waiting room. They forcibly searched his pockets and took his pocketbook. He rushed into the waiting room crying that he had been robbed.

While Matthews was telling of the robbery a scuffle ensued in the waiting room, and H. J. Roberts of Durant found that his grip had been seized. A man represented that he was a United States marshal and seized the grip. Before Roberts knew what had happened the grip was gone.

Harry McLain, Lem Wagner and John Kennedy were arrested. McLain and Wagner were held under the sum of \$1200 bail each and Kennedy's bond was fixed at \$100.
