"JIM CROW" MEASURE AS PASS-ED BY LEGISLATURE.

EFFECTIVE IN SIXTY DAYS

Railroads Must Keep Law Posted in Conspicuous Place in Depots and Coaches-Authority is Given to Conductors,

The following is Senate Bill No. t; as passed by both branches of the Oklahoma legislature and approved by Governor Haskell, Dec.

"Section I That every railway company, urban or suburban car company, street car or interarban car or rallway company, lessee, manager or receiver thereof, doing business in this State, as a commo carrier of passengers for hire, shall provide separate conches or compartments, as bereinafter provided for the accommodation of the white and negro races, which separate conches on ours shall be equal in all points of comfort and conven-

Every railroad company, street car company, urban, suburban or interurban car company shall provide for and maintain separate waiting rooms at all their passenger depots for the accommodation of the white and negro races, which separate waiting rooms shall be equal in all points of comfort GREAT and convenience.
