### RESOLUTION.

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ARDMORE, OKLAHOMA, DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF IMPROVING THAT PORTION OF G STREET SOUTHWEST, FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF STANLEY BOULEVARD TO THE NORTH LINE OF MOORE STREET, ALSO FOURTH AVENUE, FROM THE EAST LINE OF G STREET, SOUTHWEST, TO THE EAST LINE OF F STREET, SOUTHWEST, INCLUDING ALLEY CROSSINGS AND STREET INTERSECTIONS.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ARDMORE, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS:

First. That it is necessary to improve that portion of G street, southwest, from the south line of Stanley Boulevard to the north line of Moore street, also that portion of Fourth avenue from the east line of G street, southwest, to the east line of F street southwest, including alley crossings and street intersections.

Second. That such improvements shall consist of grading, paving, curbing and guttering and such other improvements as are necessary to complete in a thorough and workmanlike manner the paving and draining that portion of the street as described above.

Third. That such improvements shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, plats and specifications and within the estimates as prepared by the city engineer of the city of Ardmore, Okla., and now on file in the office of the city clerk of said city.

Fourth. That the cost of such improvements, including alley crossings and street intersections, shall be paid by special assessments levied against the property subject to assessment for said improvements as provided by an act of the legislature of the state of Oklahoma, approved April 27, 1908, entitled "An Act to Provide for the Improvement of Streets and Other Public Places Within Cities of the First Class by Grading, Paving, Macadamizing, Curbing, Guttering, and Draining the same, and Declaring an Emergency."

Fifth. That this resolution shall be published for six consecutive issues in The Daily Ardmoreite or in two issues of The Weekly Ardmoreite, a newspaper published and having a general circulation within the limits of the said City of Ardmore, Oklahoma.
