NEW LEAGUE IN TEXAS IS TALKED

Mexia and Corsicana Want to Roll Out of Berth in T-O Circuit, According to Reports

Dark clouds are hanging over the health of the Texas-Oklahoma League, and this time formation of a new league in North Texas is being anticipated.

Mexia and Corsicana have become disgruntled, it is said, and feelers have been sent out to ascertain chances for forming the new circuit. Just how many steps have been taken cannot be learned, but it is known that Ardmore is to be left out in the cold.

Walter Thompson, owner of the Ardmore franchise, is not worried over the turn of events, but is just "sitting pretty" until the agitation has settled. Thompson is assuring the fans

that he will give them just as good a team as they will support this year. Over in Paris, it is said the departure of Red Snapp is being lamented by some of the fans, and that a "light hand" committee is at work collecting souvenirs to hang on Snapp when he bids farewell to the Texas city. A new manager of the Paris team has not been selected.
