

BUTTON SHOES IN FAVOR THIS FALL




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Tobacco, the Snappy New Shoe Style—White Topped Buttoned Boots Will Be Worn—Bronze Boots With All Costumes—Glazed Kid Buttoned Tops in Charming Shades to Match Fall Costumes—Footwear for the Kidless—Laced and Buttoned Styles for the Man.

If you would be quite up to the van of the mode this fall you must possess at least one pair of tobacco boots. There is something snappy—our hardy dare to say—about the very name tobacco, as to its particular shade, it is a deep reddish brown which shines in the new soft glazed kid that makes foot and ankle look so expensively dainty. Tobacco glazed kid boots will be at their best with tailored street costumes, and town and country sport suits. This tobacco red kid looks well also with patent leather and with certain shades of light tan in buttoned uppers, and one even sees tobacco boots with uppers of white washable kid.

"But kid boots are not practical," wails the sensible woman who lives outside New York city in the metropolis one wears what fashion dictates and never minds about sensible qualities. "But there anything else that will be correct for dress-up wear?"

Woman has found that to look entire within the picture with a skirt seven or eight inches from the ground, she must wear pretty boots. Her feet are her most conspicuous feature and if they are not daintily clad her whole costume is spoiled. Far, far better call a taxi if a shower

makes the pavement wet than venture forth in sturdy weather-proof boots that makes one's short fallow and coquettish hat look positively grotesque.

The Fashionable Boot Colors.

Tobacco, spoken of above, is one of the most popular footwear shades in glazed kid. Then there are the grays, dove gray, pearl gray, smoke gray and battleship gray. There are tans, too, and an ivory tone that is very dainty with tobacco or golden brown samples. Field mouse is a very smart foot shade also. One may have a whole boot in any of these colors, or a combination of vamp in darker color and buttoned




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wear. Bronze slippers with stockings in the same shade of silk, or with flesh colored or golden shaded stockings are always dainty and charming. White slippers for evening wear are of white glazed kid rather than satin which is now the most exclusive thing. Even the bride wears white kid slippers with most beautiful stockings of hand-embroidered white silk, some embroidered and lace inset bridal hose costing as high as \$25 the pair, though a very good pair of plain white silk with white elastics may be had for about \$3.

The Button Shoe Chosen by Fashion.

Paris devalues buttoned boots with tops of light glazed kid for an army wear. Not only is the buttoned type of boot more formal in suggestion than the laced boot, which is really a sport or robbing-it style of footwear, but also the buttoned boot outlines more daintily the lines of instep and ankle, and looks much prettier under a short frock or tailleur. Skirts are being worn a little longer in New York now—only an inch or so longer, but even an inch added to a skirt makes a decided change in the ensemble. Last winter tailored skirts swung eight and even nine inches from the ground and boots had to be very high. Now the correct tailored skirt is not more than six, or at most, seven inches short—that is, from the ground—and buttoned boot tops are not quite as high as they were. But even seven inches reveals most of a charming boot and women are insistent upon the prettiest boots they can find white ankle and instep are so conspicuous.

Bronze Boots in Fashion's High Favor.
