New Mexico Senator Ascertains Great Britain Will Rule League as Constitution Now Stands.

REVISION MUST BE MADE

ALBUQUERQUE, N. M., March 14.—The present league of nations is not adopted, Great Britain will be the victor and object to America's becoming again a subsidiary country to the British empire, declared United States Senator Fall, of New Mexico, today in addressing a chamber of commerce here.

Gleaves, commanding the cruiser and transport forces.

SCOUTS OFF TODAY ON 14-MILE HIKE

Hundred Boys Will Undertake Endurance Test to Qualify for First Class.

Saturday morning the local Boy Scouts will be taken on a 14-mile endurance hike. The boys will start from scout headquarters at 9 o'clock and will go to the Y. M. C. A. camp grounds, where they will cook their own dinner.

After dinner the boys will undergo the tests for a first-class scout, including fire-building, cooking, running a mile in 12 minutes, signaling and map-making. Those failing in these qualifications will not be eligible to receive the first class scout certificate.

SENTENCED TEN YEARS FOR EVASION OF DRAFT

LOS ANGELES, March 14.—Robert Livingston of Los Angeles, convicted by court-martial for desertion amounting to the draft, was sentenced to 10 years in military prison and his sentence has been approved by the proper authorities, according to information received here today by Lieutenant Roy Meecham, judge advocate of the court-martial.

There were three Livingston brothers drafted, according to court records. George Washington Livingston was sent to Camp Lewis, feigned illness, was dismissed from the service and fled to Central America in December, 1917. He has never been apprehended.

Robert Livingston and Ben Livingston also fled while under investigation on charges of having attempted to evade service. Ben Livingston forfeited a \$10,000 cash bond. The two and their mother, Mrs. Nathan Livingston, were found in Venezuela and returned here in September, 1918.

The mother was charged with assisting her sons to evade the draft, but her case was not pressed. The court records show two sisters, Clara and Esiee Livingston, were also held under bail charged with aiding their brothers to evade service. Neither their cash bonds and disappeared and the father, Nathan Livingston, also fled while under investigation on a charge of aiding his sons in their efforts to evade service.
