

Prospects for Oklahoma reported good for May. World's Washington Bureau. WASHINGTON, D. C., May 6.—General prospects for Oklahoma crops were never brighter, the early reports of the bureau of crop estimates, United States department of agriculture today shows. Much of the crop is already in and the other planting is progressing well. The wheat crop will yield larger than in any other year, according to present indications. Conditions of wheat in all parts of the state are high, experts said.

Prospects for fruit in general in the Sooner state are very optimistic. Grass is green over the state and cattle are doing well. The number of sheep has increased and early lambing was large. Hens are forecast for kafir, milo, maize, corn and the row crops.

Ceremonial Writing Book. FINLAND IS RECOGNIZED BY BRITISH GOVERNMENT. LONDON, May 6.—The British government has recognized the independence of Finland and the de facto Finnish government, according to an announcement by Cecil Harmsworth, parliamentary secretary for foreign affairs, in the house of commons today. The announcement was greeted with cheers.

The council of foreign ministers at Paris yesterday decided that recognition would be extended to the government of Finland under certain conditions which were not disclosed.
