Special Ladies' Luncheon Will Be Given at Hotel Tulsa Saturday Noon.

Including theater parties, a luncheon and automobile ride and concluding with a dance at Elks' hall, Akdar temple local order of Mystic Shrine, will inaugurate ladies' day Saturday, May 17, with one of the most complete entertaining programs in the history of Tulsa Shrineism, arranged especially for the benefit of wives, mothers, sisters, daughters and sweethearts of the Nobles.

Edward Soph, in charge of arrangements, announces that complete program will be off the press today for distribution. Many Shriners and their ladies from out of town will also be entertained Saturday and the program committee is making extensive arrangements for the reception and entertainment of these.

All ladies who are eligible, according to the above classification, are requested to telephone either Francis John at 6433 or Mr. Ash at 5410, to register, secure and make reservations for the luncheon at noon Saturday. Ladies are also requested to inform the registrar that they will or will not have a car available for use in the automobile sight seeing trip.

All ladies who expect to take part in the program must register at 10 a. m. A registration booth will be maintained on the mezzanine floor, Hotel Tulsa. At the time of registration, coupons, entitling the holder to admission to matinees at the Majestic, Palace and Rialto theaters, will be issued.

Women Object to Treaty

PARIS, May 14.—The peace conference today received from the women's international conference for permanent peace at Zurich the resolution adopted yesterday by the conference, denouncing the terms of peace with Germany. The resolution declares that the terms tacitly sanctioned secret diplomacy, deny the principle of self-determination, recognize the right of the victor to the spoils of war and violate principles of justice. Rule of force, it declared, is continued by the financial and economic clauses.

Milk Drivers Strike

CHICAGO, May 14.—Three thousand milk wagon drivers today went on strike in Chicago, virtually tying up the city's milk supply. Representatives of the drivers, who are asking wage increases from \$24 a week and commissions to 12 1/2 and 15, and commissions, said that emergency deliveries would be made to hospitals and baby asylums.
