FEAST OF THE WEEKS OBSERVED IN TULSA

Feast of Dedication of the Jewish Youth Calls for New Pledges of Their Faith.

Shabbath, the Feast of the Weeks, in biblical times a feast of the first fruits of a farmer's harvest at the end of the first seven weeks of harvest began yesterday, June 4. Having changed from what was formerly a harvest ceremonial with agricultural offerings as tokens of thanksgiving for the new crops, transformations brought about within the last century have added additional character to the Feast of the Weeks by introducing a confirmation ceremony in connection with the observance. Leaders of returned emigrants have made it a feast of consecration of the Jewish youth, boys and girls, to the ancient covenant of their fathers. The intent and purpose of the confirmation service is the yearly attesting of their faith and loyalty by the children of the religious schools of the reformed congregations. The service symbolizes a graduation from the religious school where the boys and girls have been taught biblical and Jewish history, Jewish ethics, Hebrew and Jewish literature.

Accepting the position of business secretary of the local Y. M. C. A., he made a splendid record for himself by his integrity, business ability and high principles. Enlisting in the army in January, 1918, he was sent overseas immediately as secretary of the Y. M. C. A. connected with the Tulsa ambulances of the 42nd division. Long, hard service on the western front during six months of the hardest fighting, gained during an encounter in the Lorraine sector and sent to southern France for recuperation and thence back to the front near the firing line, was the career of the young Tulsa unit in the armistice brought an end to the struggle.
