SENIORS ADOPT CLASS PINS FOR ALL GRADS

Tulsa Students Adopt Their Own Model for Finishing Classes—Design Drawn in Art Department.

Adoption of class pins and rings of a uniform design for the present and future senior classes of the high school was the result of a meeting of the officers and representative committees of all four classes of the school yesterday afternoon.

Not only will the action be more economical for the students, but it is believed that it will be far more satisfactory to have a uniform pin for each succeeding senior class than to purchase from pin salesmen one of the old pins that have been sold for years to senior classes all over the country.

The pin will be one that it will be impossible for any other school to duplicate. The design was drawn by the art department of the local high school and is symbolic of the Latin motto of the institution, which stands for enthusiasm, honesty, moral courage and loyalty. In the center is the reproduction of the Great Spirit which stands in the center of the main corridor of the building. The words "Tulsa High" and the date complete the design, which is suitable for either a pin or ring.
