

END OF WAR DAY CELEBRATED HERE

Continued from page one. The real, regular people of Tulsa, as one of the speakers called them, celebrated the first anniversary of Armistice day with an impressive luncheon program given at Hotel Tulsa under the auspices of the Tulsa Advertising club at noon.

Sing Patriotic Songs. Every civic organization of the city, together with all the women's clubs and the American Legion were represented in the throng that filled the grillroom to capacity.

Invocation by Rev. Meade Dutt, pastor of the First Christian church, was followed by the singing of "America." W. O. Buck, chairman of the day, presented Mrs. George Stanley who rendered a vocal solo.

Several vocal selections were rendered by the women of the Hyeckka club, prior to the introduction of the two principal speakers of the day, Lee Levering and Rev. J. W. Abel.

Recalling the autocratic power by the trusts a few years ago, Levering, the first speaker, declared that the pendulum had swung to the opposite direction.

"Sam Gompers does not any more rule this country today than did John D. Rockefeller about 10 years summation of peace, he said: "You ago," he said. "Speaking of the consummation of peace he said, "You talk about the peace treaty being about peace; you can talk about the league of nations bringing about peace; they may help and I hope they will, but until the fundamental principles of Christianity are

embedded into the heart of every American citizen, we can never have peace."

After reading from The World the murderous creed and anarchistic principles of the Russian workers' union, Rev. Abel vigorously assailed the authors of the dangerous propaganda and urged that they and others who worked against the welfare of the country be deported.

"Americanism puts the good of the community and the state above the narrow, selfish interests of any organization or individual, and the time has come when we as true blooded Americans must speak out against that thing which confronts the country today.

"America must close the sluiceways on anarchistic immigration. We must catch up in our program of Americanization. It will require at least 50 years for us to Americanize the vast hordes of foreigners that we already have within our gates."

After reviewing the philosophy and national ideals that resulted in the downfall of the German nation, the minister declared that the world needed a new soul. "The first constructive number in our program of rebuilding the world must be to

place God upon the throne of the universe."

W. A. Cease was given a vote of thanks for the beautiful red, white and blue decorations that gave the dining room its patriotic aspect. The program closed with the singing of "The Star Spangled Banner."

Y. W. C. A. STARTS MOVE TO RAISE BUILDING FUND
