In the Osage. The Midco Petroleum company's well No. 14 in the southeast of 24-12-12 in producing 29 barrels of 9,000 feet.

Midco's No. 21 in the southwest of 24-12-12 was shut yesterday at 2,100 feet and is making 500 barrels. Well No. 8 on the same lease was shut and is making 150 barrels. No. 7 on the same farm is on top of the sand and will be drilled in the early part of next week.

Some company is rigging up for well No. 11 and 14 in the southeast of 13-27-10, which is a diagonal offset to the big typew-RKelly Phillips well.

Oklahoma Producing & Refining company's No. 8 on the Osage-Widling lease in the northwest of 11-27-11 was shut with 250 quarts of gelatin at a depth of 1,300 feet. It is producing an initial production of 30 barrels.

Billings Field. The Midco Petroleum company is building rig for their Williams No. 11 in the southeast of 20-24-14. Robertson No. 15 in the southwest of 20-24-14 is drilling at 400 feet. No. 6 on the same lease is a rig.

With the Oil Men. M. M. Travis, president of the Midco Petroleum company, is in the east on business.

George Shryock is in the city on his way back to Wichita and says that the lease owned by his company—the Arkansas River Gas company—in 20-24-14 is making 1,200 barrels of oil per day. Mr. Shryock says his company has also recently drilled in a well on the Thomas farm which is one-half mile south of the above acreage, in 20-24-14, and the well is producing 200 barrels. This is the furthest well south in the Ething pool.

A. E. Aaronson, president of the Paloma Oil company, has just returned from a visit to New York. Mr. Aaronson was accompanied by his wife.

Fred R. Leitcher, president of the New York Oil company, and family have just returned from a visit to Oklahoma City and southwestern Oklahoma.

The directors acted upon recommendations sent to President C. D. Keith by the organization by the Texas and Gulf Coast organization. The new eight-hour day will put the workers in the fields on a three-shift basis instead of two as at present. The wage increasing to \$2.25 per day, both a maximum and minimum wage, amounts to approximately 46 per cent. The maximum will apply only to men in the employ of a given company one year.

In cases where the present pay exceeds the maximum set by the association, no decrease in pay will be made. It is expected that the pipe line companies will endorse the new agreement within a short time.

The following table shows the minimum and maximum scale to be paid according to the classifications of the workers: Drillers, minimum, \$275 per month; maximum \$300 per month. Station firemen and pumpers, minimum \$127.50 per month; maximum \$165 per month. Gauge pushers, minimum \$200 per month; maximum \$220 per month. Connecticut foremen, minimum \$200 per month; maximum \$220 per month. Derrick men, minimum \$5 per day; maximum \$5 per day. Roughnecks, minimum \$5.25 per day; maximum \$5.50 per day. Drilling rig helpers and foremen, minimum \$5.25 per day; maximum \$5.50 per day.

Paragon Raises Oil Output. Next month the Paragon Refining company's big East Side plant will be refining 8,000 barrels of crude oil a day, most of which will be brought to Toledo by the company's pipe line which connects with the Burks pipeline. The plant is located in Waurika, Okla. The present daily output of the refinery here is 3,000 barrels. The company expects to have the pipe line completed by May 1. When it is in full operation it can place 11,000 barrels of crude oil in Toledo daily. To handle the increased pumping, additional equipment is being installed at the station at Wagon.
