

### LOVEJOY LAUDS IRISH REPUBLIC

#### New York Speaker Pleads for Immediate Recognition.

### ADOPT RESOLUTIONS

#### High School Meeting Goes on Record Favoring Mason House Measure.

Enthusiasm made up for what might have been lacking in the size of the audience which listened to Dr. Owen R. Lovejoy, of New York, at the high school auditorium when he spoke on the Irish question under the auspices of the local chapter of the friends of Irish freedom.

Analyzing the present status of the Irish republic, Dr. Lovejoy pleaded for its immediate recognition. He declared that there is no religious question involved and that the Irish people themselves were remarkably unanimous in their championing of the cause.

James P. Gilmore presided at the meeting, and Father McInerney of Chanute, Kan., offered a prayer at the opening of the meeting. Vocal solos were rendered by Miss Agnes Dunigan and Mrs. John R. Hadley, who also led the audience in the singing of "America." Mayor T. D. Evans was also present at the meeting.

Following are the resolutions adopted unanimously by those present:

"Whereas, the people of Ireland, by ballot in a general election, have established the Independent Republic of Ireland, and

"Whereas, both house of congress of the United States have already given their judgment recognizing the right of the Irish people to a government of their own choice,

"Be It Resolved, That we respectfully urge upon the foreign affairs committee of the house of representatives to report favorably the Mason bill, so that a consular and diplomatic corps be accredited to the new republic, and

"Be It Further Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be sent to Congressman Howard with the request that they be presented to the chairman of the foreign affairs committee.
