

SHERIFF TARGET FOR PROSECUTION

Lynching of Belton Cannot Be Investigated by Special Court.

COURT POWER LIMITED

Can Inquire Only Into the Accusation of Failure to Perform Duty.

Investigation of the official acts of Sheriff James Woolley in connection with the removal from the county jail August 21 of the Belton and subsequent lynching at the hands of a mob near Red Park, will begin this morning before U. S. W. Eling, assistant attorney general of the state, Thomas I. Munroe, county attorney and other county officers.

The hearing, for which many witnesses have been subpoenaed, will be confined solely to the question as to whether the sheriff and his deputies in the county jail at the time the mob made its way for the prisoner charged with the murder of Homer Kida, a taxicab driver, two weeks ago, were guilty of acts of omission in allowing the mob leaders to take charge of the prisoner.

The hearing which was to have begun Monday morning, was postponed because of the legal holiday, which made it almost impossible to obtain witnesses needed for an investigation of the charges that the sheriff did not use proper precautions in preventing the mob from taking possession of the prisoner.

In a statement made Monday Attorney King quoted from the senate bill which grants the attorney general of the state power to make an investigation of any state, county or municipal officer charged with a crime, or in accused of failure to properly perform his sworn duties. It is relative to the alleged acts of omission on the part of Sheriff Woolley in failing to protect his prisoner that the investigation will be made.

Under the state law, should the special court of inquiry find reason to believe the sheriff did not take proper precaution to protect Belton, the court may then file an information in the supreme court of the state or in the district court of Tulsa county and the sheriff be tried in an other civil case.

Should the jury see fit to remove the sheriff, his successor would be appointed by the county commissioners of this county. The law, however, makes no provision for the removal of any officer in the state by the special court, and such removal can come only after a trial of the accused officer by a jury upon an information filed by the court.

While the court cannot investigate any except the acts of the sheriff and his deputies, a mass of information may be gathered which can be presented to the Tulsa county grand jury which is called for September 16, and in this way assist county authorities in ascertaining the identity of the leaders of the mob which hung Belton after the letter confessed to fatally wounding Nida.

CHARGES GRAFT IN PRICE HIKE

International Harvester Company Faces New Trust Charges.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 6.—Declaring prices of farm implements to have been increased without warrant through "concerted action" of manufacturers and dealers, the federal trade commission in a report made public today recommends revocation of anti-trust proceedings against the International Harvester company, and institution of judicial proceedings against implement manufacturers and dealers.

The commission declared that its investigation, which was ordered by the senate, disclosed that in the period between 1912 and 1918 prices paid by farmers for implements advanced 22 per cent with the greater portion of the increase coming in 1917 and 1918. This increase, the commission asserts, was larger than warranted by advances in the costs and expenses of the manufacturers and dealers and resulted in unusually large profits.

Notwithstanding the increase, farmers of the country, according to the commission's report, "were not prevented from making as much profit as before because the prices of farm products increased to an even greater extent." The report adds, however, that if present implement prices are maintained, while prices of farm products decrease, high implement costs may well become a factor in preventing the farmer from making a fair profit.

"The partial dissolving of the International Harvester company in 1918," declares the commission's report, "did not change the dominating position of that company in the harvesting machinery line and will not do so, while the McCormick and Deering plants and the steel business remain united under its control, either directly or by common ownership of stock."

"The dominating position of the International Harvester company is chiefly with respect to the harvesting machine line and particularly the combine harvester."

between employer and employe is justice. I wish we could have the industry restored, not in the old way, but through a joint committee of employers and employes, not to run the business, but to promote and maintain the mutuality of interest and the fullest understanding. Herein lies the surest remedy for most of our ills.

We cannot have compulsory arbitration, because all parties must consent to establish arbitration and enforce its conclusion. I think we can have, and ought to have, optional arbitration. The best thought of the day commends this way to settlement.

"The wage scale which contemplates a rental cost in one place might be wholly inadequate to meet the cost in another, and a nationalized scale would work an injustice. This principle was developed in the recent railroad controversies.

"This brings me to the subject of railway legislation and the enactment of the Commerce-Embry bill restoring the railways to the lawful owners. We owed it to the railway owners to restore their property, seized for war service, just as we owe the return of the people's money invested in government loans. In five and thoughtful America we do not take advantage of wars (until so change the regular order of things). I am well aware that many earnest railway workers and advocates of the socialist plan preferred to take the railroads and put them under the operation of the employes, but that was not in keeping with

We were bound to make the return. I favored it for the additional reason that I do not believe in government ownership.

"I do not pretend to say the railway act is perfect. Indeed I do know it is not. But congress was dealing with a problem of first importance and it had to speed the legislation. It does not guarantee dividends, it limits them. It did make a six months' guarantee, but this was to enable the stupendous financing of rehabilitation. Railway workers are made a preferred class and the government had singled out railway workers to see that their best treatment is a matter of public pledge. This is progress.

"The law does not contain an anti-strike clause. You cannot take away from any man the right to quit his employment, but it does aim at the prompt, instant grant of justice, full justice and justice, men in the best guarantee of all civilization. It does not interfere with collective bargaining. On the contrary it facilitates it.

"I want to see profiteering isolated and punished. It is a moral wrong and an economic robbery. The same results on profiteering, mostly dealing with petty offenders, do not deeply impress the coun-
