**STILLWATER, Okla.**, Sept. 12.—Dr. Fred D. Merritt, who comes from Kansas State agricultural college at Manhattan, has been elected professor of economics at Oklahoma A. & M. college. He will also serve this year as acting dean of the school of commerce and agriculture, during the absence of Dr. H. W. Mowbray, who will be away this year working for an advanced degree.

Dr. Merritt received his master's and doctor's degrees from the University of Texas. He has had wide and varied experience in several fields of teaching and in agricultural business. He has been professor of social science at the University of Oregon and was associate professor at K. S. A. M.

J. E. Reed (Ph. D. Yale, 1912) will fill a newly created assistant professorship in the school of education. He is a specialist in experimental psychology and education. He has had experience as a teacher at Yale university and at the University of Pennsylvania, and since 1914 has been professor of psychology and education at Gustavus Adolphus college.

Mark Martin, who has been associate professor of mechanical engineering at the A. & M. college of Texas, is now professor of mechanical engineering here. Professor Martin received his master's degree in engineering at Cornell University in 1911. He is formerly member of the engineering faculty of the University of Arkansas and was assistant professor of mechanical engineering at the state college of Washington.

S. Hatt, city superintendent of schools at Chandler, Okla., has been employed as professor of history. He is an A. M. man from Island Stanford university and has served in educational fields for several years.

Miss Grace M. Stafford is new director of physical education for women. Miss Stafford has received training at the University of Wisconsin and the Chicago Normal School of Physical Education. She was a Ph. D. graduate from the University of Wisconsin. Miss Stafford has served as head of the department at Northwestern state normal of Michigan and during one summer was in charge of physical training for women at the University of Chicago.
