"March of Nations Will Be Presented by High School Students."

Calendan day will be observed by Tulsa high school this year when the history department will stage a pageant, "The March of the Nations," in the auditorium on Peabody October 22. The school represents the history of civilization from Antiquity to the present.

Dances interpreting the spirit of the story will be given by students of the girls' physical training department.
