Eldorado, the Center of Interest

A fullman carload of oil men left last night for Eldorado, Arkansas, and will take the morning train for the town and will be led by Jules Constantine, whose firm has made a big killing in the immediate vicinity. With the party are Messrs. Jones and Mattox, who donated 80 acres on which the well was drilled and the party will be met by J. J. Victor, geologist for the Constantine people, who recommended the property to Constantine after Bruce Hunt and the party had looked good. Victor had checked the acreage. Mr. Victor is given credit by the Constantine people and is also responsible for the structure which appears to be making good at Ralston and Pawnee county.

The bunch will find things much to their liking at Eldorado as it certainly looks like an oil country over there. It has looked good enough to Tulsa operators as to attract such people as W. G. Skelley and Grant Stebbins, both of whom appear to be inside the money. The well, which is casing all the excitement, was almost given up as a failure on account of the cavity formation but was cemented on top of the sand and finally drilled in Sunday by Dr. Hussey, who is in charge. That the well will lead to a lot of drilling goes without saying, and seems to indicate that there will be a lot of new lots drilled later on, and that in the meantime the White Oil corporation and the Constantine people, together with the Home Oil and Refining, are all likely to get oil by deeper drilling. There are many reports in circulation as to water in the well, one which was received by the Prairie Oil & Gas Co. to the effect that the well is making 10,000 barrels of oil and water, 75 per cent of which is water.

The bunch will arrive on the ground this morning and will soon be in a position to give exact details. There will be plenty of fun for the boys making the trip and here's hoping that they find things much to their liking. It has been easily recognized for a long time that Eldorado is situated in a country that looks like an oil country and the ground is just rolling enough to remind one of the best parts of the Illinois field. If there is much water coming with the oil, it will only prove that there must be a lot of water in the oil, and there would be no oil coming from the well so that whatever is said about water can do but little injury, as nowadays there are many pools

Perry, general manager for Cosden & Co., is back from Philadelphia, where he went to meet Mrs. Perry, who has been enjoying a trip to South America via London, and speaking of conditions, Mr. Perry says: "It is absolutely necessary that the supply of crude be kept up, as there is no other way to meet the demands of trade and the big spring business which confronts us. If we should get some bad weather, which is very probable from now on, production will fall off rapidly, and as soon as the traffic has slowed its pace, the capacity, which is soon to be accomplished, it is doubtful if there will be near oil enough to go around. A big factor that must not be overlooked is that the refinery is now taking a large share of the export stuff, and is wanting more."
