**Galli-Curei, Modern Patti Closes Tulsa's Musical Season With Concert**

Melita Galli-Curei, soprano of the Metropolitan Opera company, sang here Saturday evening in Concert hall, her magnificent production and superb voice scoring an immense success for her. **Convict Bond Broker on Forgery Charge**

SPokane, Wash., April 24.—Jay E. Hough, former bond broker, was found guilty by a jury in superior court of first degree forgery. Hough was charged with having forged the names of officers on an issue of fraudulent bonds, which it was testified were given to James F. Callahan of Wallace, Idaho, in exchange for genuine securities.

In a confession in January, Hough declared that frauds against Callahan through exchange of fraudulent bonds would reach \$300,000 or more. His defense was that he had forged the bonds under threats of death by his partner, John B. Millicholland.

Millicholland committed suicide when officers went to arrest him, following Hough's confession.
