

## Attractive Swimming Pool Constructed By Tulsa Man

A private swimming pool which may prove tempting to a few nymphs is being built by Samuel A. Orcutt, wealthy Tulsa property owner, on his grounds at 1605 south Peoria, at a cost of \$1,500, 000. Will be ready for use next week.

Oval in shape, the pool is constructed of reinforced concrete with a Bedford stone coping. A rainbow of colors will be reflected from the pool surface, as it is painted blue within, colored lights will be diffused from a large bronze lantern mounted on a pedestal in the center, and the rays of a spotlight may be played from a side light every five minutes. A profusion of flowers, palms, Christmas trees, Indian blanket, and other trees and shrubs have been placed around the pool, and a series of steps of tiered design will surround it. The pool, which has been in process of construction for several months, will be spangled with a private swimming party. It was designed by Mr. Orcutt.

## ONE MAN EDITED SIXTEEN PAPERS

Regular Hearst in Running Small Weekly Newspapers

TONICA CITY, Aug. 9.—Herman Knabe, twin brother of Otto Knabe, former big league baseball star and now manager of the Tonica Indians, was a regular William Randolph Hearst or Nelson McLean all in himself, a few years ago, when he owned a total of 16 weekly newspapers at one time in Montana. He not only owned but ran them, syndicating his editorials for the entire 16 and with a local man of his own to take care of the news. Now he only did his own newspaper on the Bryan ratio, but he started the most of them himself, going into a news-paperless town and making a contract to run a paper provided the town would give him so much advertising for a year, and 16 of the towns did.

Herman Knabe was in Ponca City recently to draw a dividend from his home in Shamrock, where he has been busy as an oil driller since 1916. He is now gradually building upward again financially, owns several big acreage lease tracts for oil and gas and expects when he cleans up to start another newspaper. He maintains Knabe is a date, this time, and a big date. The Knabe brothers came direct to Ellits Hill, between 30 and 40 years ago, from Germany. Both became baseball players of note, while Otto made it his profession while Herman became entangled in the newspaper game and was a reporter during the time that he was picking up English on the old New York American-Post and later on the World and other New York papers.

The Japanese acceptance makes it certain that the disarmament conference will convene in Washington on Armistice day, as all the other powers invited previously indicated their willingness to accept that date.
