

## NEW JITTERY LINE GRANTED PERMIT

Irving Place and Park Hill Will Be Served by New Route

## RAILWAYS AGAINST IT

Say Street Car Service Will Be Cut Because of Loss of Business

Recent assurance on the part of street place and Park hill residents that they want need and had been paying for street car service between them and the business district was confirmation to the establishment of such a service over the route of street railway representatives at the commission meeting Friday morning. The resolution favoring establishment of the line was passed with the reserving clause that licenses are to be granted only with the approval of the park board relative to routing through Owen park.

The line will come into that district it will be impossible to route the park street cars, the resolution does itself into the necessity for closing between liner and streetcar & vice versa, declared R. V. Miller, general manager of the Oklahoma City Railway company. Two cars running on a 15-minute schedule handle from 1,800 to 1,800 people daily, he said, and this traffic barely makes expenses, he told the commissioners. Jittery service will be given on Eastern street and around Main street station, B. Hubbard of the Tulsa Street Railway company stated. Then seven and a half minute service would probably be changed to 10-minute service, he said, if the new jittery line is established.

**Many Residents Opposed.** County Treasurer Wayne L. County spoke for residents of the districts to be served by the new jittery line, who were opposed against its establishment, saying that the objections were based upon two things—noise and the routing of the line through Owen park.

That it was not the paving but the assessments which they contested were wrong, that formed the basis for their protest was the statement made by residents of Fourth street in objecting to the paving of that street. "I am not in favor of paving of Fourth street," said C. H. Whittemore, appearing for the Real Estate exchange association for the speeding up of the paving of that section of Fourth street. The matter was deferred over until the return of the city engineer and will be taken up again next Friday. Friends of citizens living on Clinton against paving of that street from Fourth to Eleventh were approved.

Licenses of all hucksters who have police cards will be revoked, following investigation, upon order of the commission to the license inspector.

## Committee Still Favors Fire Law

**Believe Ordinance Is to Best Interests of Both Whites and Negroes**

The ruling of the district court that the city ordinance extending the fire limits over certain parts of the city of Tulsa occupied by negroes is illegal and that the city is without power to enforce it has in no way changed the attitude of the reconstruction committee, whose members recommended its passage. At a meeting of the committee in the municipal auditorium last evening, a resolution was passed that it believed the ordinance was justified in its view of the best interests of the city and that it recommended to the city commissioners as to the establishment of fire limits in that particular part of the city.

In taking this action, the committee pointed out the difficulties involved in making the recommendation, that regarding the possess of the negroes, the city did not have sufficient evidence for the safety of the negroes, to protect adjacent property from a recurrence of the fire of June 1, to bring about the location of industrial advancement to the railroad through the business included in the fire limits, and for the best interest not only of the negroes but of the property owners and residents of the white community.

The county commissioners will be asked by the reconstruction committee to relate to each ad valorem taxes as have accrued against properties contained within the burned area during 1921 in the event that the owner is unable to rebuild upon the property and is without funds to pay the taxes.
