

CHORUS TO GIVE SECOND CONCERT

Feature Will Be Famous Zoellner Stringed Quartet

Tulsa's largest organization of men singers and an organization comparing favorably with others of its kind in the country, the Tulsa Male Chorus will deliver its second concert of the season Wednesday evening at convention hall with the nationally-known Zoellner quartet furnishing the stringed music of the evening.

A hundred voices, approximately, will be lifted in four choruses varying in type from "Roses I'll Rose to Thee" and "The King and the Queen" to "Goliath and Good-Night" and "A Song of Winter." Robert Ulrich Carron will direct, succeeding Ernest Prang Stumm, one of the organizers of the chorus and its director during his residence in Tulsa, which terminated last week.

The Zoellner have played in nearly all the European centers of art and in practically every important city in the United States and Canada and during their present concert work on this continent have given approximately one thousand one hundred concerts.

CHICAGO, March 20.—Chicago responded liberally to the American Legion campaign started today to obtain employment for 700,000 former service men throughout the country, headquarters here announced. Throughout the day steady line of former soldiers filed into the employment office and nearly were given jobs. During the first hour permanent employment was obtained for 10 men.

About two hundred and fifty persons applied for work during the day and 68 had been given positions at 3 o'clock. Legion officials expressed themselves as greatly pleased over the results.
