INDIAN PREACHER EXPIRES

Guiseppi di Gabrielli, Who Had Himself Crucified, Dies in Italy. SAN ANTONIO, Texas, April 15. Rev. Guiseppi di Gabrielli, who was crucified by the Indians of Oaxaca a year ago, died in Mexico City, according to word received here today.

Di Gabrielli was well known in Mexico City and other parts of the republic for his sermons. He claimed to be the reincarnation of Christ and preached to people that he was the new redeemer. During a holy week a year ago he forced Indians of the town of Tequitlan, Oaxaca, to crucify him, making them believe he was Christ. Only quick intervention of authorities who took him down from the cross where he had been nailed, saved his life.
