

The World's News By Telegraph BRYAN'S PLAN OF CAMPAIGN

His Speeches to be Less Radical Than LaFollette's; More Moderate Than Teddy's.

SIX-LEW. Lincoln, Neb., June 23.—Here are the plans of William Jennings Bryan, as outlined by a close friend and supporter: "Mr. Bryan," the friend said, "is endowed with the passion for hard work. He has outlined plans for a presidential campaign the most determined, resolute and, at the same time, the most dignified in the history of the nation. He has no doubt of his nomination."

"At his home at Fairview, Mr. Bryan will receive delegations from all parts and speeches will be made, but they will be quiet, dignified addresses. "In the life of Bryan nothing has come by chance. When he planned to charm a democratic convention with his oratory he worked on his effort for a year in advance. When he planned to capture the following democratic nomination by acclamation, he went about it in the same manner. After his St. Louis convention episode he participated in the campaign enough to show his good will. Then he outlined a globe-trotting tour which attracted the attention of the world. "Soon after Mr. Bryan's return, Fairview will be remodeled and a large porch will be added. Landscape gardeners will transform the rolling lawn into a garden, where 10,000 persons may hear a political speech. "Mr. Bryan will not rush around the country in special trains. He will make but two trips. He will deliver one masterpiece, an oration which will be carefully prepared, and will contain some matchless Bryanic paragraphs. As for the remainder of the speeches, they will be full of dignity. Just before the campaign closes, Mr. Bryan will make another supreme appeal. "Mr. Bryan will not join in the hue and cry against corporations. His speeches will be opposed to extreme and radical ideas like those of Mr. LaFollette, and he will be moderate in his expressions, as compared with Mr. Roosevelt. Instead of scaring capital he will reassure. Trusts, he will urge, should be curbed, but curbed with no injustice to capitalists or investors. "Mr. Bryan will not interfere with the sentiments of his party. He will act in an indifferent manner toward indorsements, and urge the claims of anyone who should aspire to the nomination. At the same time, the indorsements will come with such frequency that it will be extremely discouraging for the opposing candidates. "Mr. Hearst will be humored and Mr. Parker ignored. During the months after his return to Lincoln Mr. Bryan will make public his ideas on the political systems of foreign countries. All the while he will be directing the views of the national democratic organization in a safe and sane channel."

COLE FOR CHAIRMAN.

Of Republican State Central Committee, According to Rumor. St. Paul, June 23.—Dr. A. B. Cole of Fergus Falls was represented today as the possible new chairman of the state central committee, but the contemplated selection could not be confirmed. Mr. Cole, the nominee, refuses to give out any information. Dr. Cole is a brother of the nominee and was in charge of his pre-convention campaign. In fact, he has been at his side ever since the beginning of the late contest and up to the present time. The talk grew out of the presence of Mr. Cole at Minneapolis, yesterday, and his conference with leaders there.

A FATAL WEDDING.

Syrian Youth Shot on Way to Marriage Scene. Budapest, June 23.—A Syrian landowner named Michael Radej was accidentally shot on his way to church to be married. It is the custom of the country for wedding guests to keep up a few jokes from guns and revolvers. A 16-year-old bride was seemingly killed yesterday at Drykoff, in Bohemia, on the way back from the wedding ceremony. In this case, however, after the body had been taken to the mortuary, the bridegroom and the wedding guests went to the inn and danced all night, as if nothing had happened. At another village wedding in lower Austria, one of the bride's relatives had his hand blown off by the bursting of his pistol.

TO CROSS THE ALPS.

Remarkable Ballooning Trip is Planned by Aeronauts. Geneva, June 23.—One of the most remarkable ballooning feats that will be attempted this year will be the passage of the Alps. Queen Margherita of Italy offered a handsome cup some time ago to the first man who crossed from Switzerland to Italy by balloon. Seven aeronauts will attempt the feat this summer. The passage of the Alps has been attempted by balloon many times before, but always unsuccessfully. The famous Swiss balloonist, Spelterini, nearly lost his life in one of his attempts. Of the seven competitors in this year's race, M. Dumontet, the Frenchman, will ascend from Chamolix to cross the Mont Blanc range. The others will ascend from various points in Switzerland.
