ARE BUILDING

Has Good Effect on the Contractors.

The vast amount of railroad extension work which has been going on in North Dakota for the past year and still continues is having a marked effect in building and financial circles. Wherever the railroads go, new towns spring up to dot the prairies and the growth and development of many is miraculous. As a result building operations of tremendous extent are being opened up by the railroads, and architects, contractors, carpenters and laborers of all classes are kept unusually busy. The building boom has also a favorable effect on the financial institutions of the state which are doing a loaning business, for it makes an increased demand for money. The local institutions are feeling the effects of this and are deriving great benefit. The head of one of them stated yesterday that the extension of the Soo road from Thief River Falls to Kenmare and that of the Great Northern from Aneta to Devils Lake which had resulted in the building up of a number of new towns has caused a remarkable increase in the demand for loans, which is much greater than at this time last year. It is expected that the extension of the Milwaukee through the southwestern part of the state and the further extensions contemplated by the Soo from Kenmare and Underwood will have the same effect of stimulating the financial market.

GREAT FLEETS OF WORLD.

Vessels Built and Building by Leading Maritime Powers.

A return showing the fleets of Great Britain, France, Russia, Germany, Italy, the United States of America and Japan, on March 31, 1906, distinguishing battleships built and building, torpedo vessels, torpedo boat destroyers, torpedo boats and submarines, built and building, was issued as a parliamentary white paper yesterday.

The number of battleships of these countries is as follows: Great Britain 61, France 28, Russia 12, Germany 11, United States 15, Japan 11. Coast defense vessels, armored; France 9, Russia 6, Germany 11, United States 11, Japan 3.

Cruisers of all classes: Great Britain 114, France 57, Russia 15, Germany 15, Italy 25, United States 35, Japan 26. Torpedo vessels, torpedo boat destroyers and torpedo boats: Great Britain 251, France 301, Russia 247, Germany 128, Italy 152, United States 54, Japan 111.

Submarines: Great Britain 25, France 39, Russia 13, Germany 1, Italy 2, United States 8, Japan 5. Great Britain is the only country returning scouts, the number entered being 8.

Under the building return it is shown that Great Britain is building 6 first-class battleships, 10 armored cruisers, 18 torpedo boat destroyers and 15 submarines. France 6 first-class battleships, 23 torpedo boat destroyers, 25 torpedo boats and 22 submarines. Russia: Four first-class battleships, 4 armored cruisers, 1 first class protected cruiser, 29 torpedo boat destroyers and 15 submarines. Germany
