Inventor Sues Railway Companies for Infringing on Rights.

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 11.—The Call says that a bill of complaint will be filed in the United States court here as the commencement of one of the most important suits ever tried in any court. Binson Bidwell, who claims to be the original inventor of the system by which all the electric roads of the country are operated, is the principal complainant.


