estly laboring, and are in favor of the strictest measures looking to exclusion of both the cheap labor of China and Japan from in any way coming in competition with American labor. We therefore believe that the exclusion acts of Congress should embrace both classes, namely Chinese and Japanese.

"We heartily commend the record that the State of Oregon has made and that the County of Clatsop has made under Republican administration, and we point with pride to the splendid conduct of the office of secretary of state by our esteemed fellow-citizen, Hon. F. I. Dunbar, and recommend that our delegates to the state convention support him first, last and all the time;

"We realize that in the present contest for the office of United States senator from the State of Oregon, that Clatsop County's candidate, the Hon. C. W. Fulton, is one of the most prominent, and that all persons irrespective of party, ought to gladly welcome the opportunity of doing everything in their power, to secure that office for him, as we consider that the highest compliment within the gift of the people of the State of Oregon, that could be paid to Clatsop County, would be the election of Mr. Fulton to that office; We, therefore, earnestly request the people of Clatsop County to assist us by all honorable means within their power to secure Mr. Fulton's election, for the further reason that it would be an immense advantage to have a representative from Clatsop County upon the floor of the highest legislative body in the land;

"Fisheries—Clatsop County's present and future prosperity depends largely upon its fishing industry. We therefore favor liberal appropriations for the propagation of salmon and other food fish. We heartily endorse the plan proposed by the Columbia River Fishermen's Protective Union to restrict the location and use of all stationary gear and appliances including the abolition of all stationary gear above tide water, and we hereby pledge our candidates for the legislature to this policy, and request them to use every honorable means to secure the above results. We also heartily favor the plan proposed by the above named union, and by it submitted to the secretary of war and to the members of Congress from Oregon and to its senators, prohibiting the location of any more traps in the Columbia River, according to the plan adopted by the Union. We also pledge our legislative candidates to secure all legislation which will be beneficial to the fishing industry and its preservation.

"Good Roads—Realizing that good roads are a necessity to the development of our county, and that the work already commenced in that line should be completed, we pledge our candidates for county judge and commissioner to a judicious and economical expenditure of the money coming from the special tax levied for the construction of the road to the Nehalem Valley, and to the immediate completion of that highway. We also pledge them to the policy of securing good roads in the other portions of the county, and to the improvement of those already laid out, and that the portable sawmills and rock crusher owned by the county shall be used continuously on the different roads to the end that they may be speedily placed in proper shape for travel. We believe the time has come when county road matters should be entirely removed from politics, and therefore pledge our legislative candidates to endeavor to secure the passage of such road laws as will insure that result, and give us a better system of roads.

"We hereby pledge each and every candidate on the Republican ticket to an honest and economical administration of public affairs, looking to a decrease in the amount of taxation, and call the attention of the public to the fact that during the present administration not one cent of a shortage in the public funds of Clatsop County has appeared, although several times the books of the county officials have been expeted by competent men.
