At the end of the first bout Jenkins' seconds had to carry him to his corner and administer restoratives. In the second bout, seeing he was sure to lose, Jenkins deliberately placed a strangle hold on Gotch and when the Iowa boy got away Jenkins aimed a vicious swing at him.

The match was for a \$2000 purse and a \$2000 side bet.

Vancouver, B. C., Jan. 27.—The little steamer Zaolin, carrying mail between Juneau and Sumdum, which was on January 20, 12 days overdue from Windham bay, is believed to have been lost with all on board. It is believed at least half a dozen passengers were on her when she left Windham bay. Her crew numbered six men.

The citizens of Juneau and owners of the Zaolin have made up a fund and have chartered the steamer Rustler to prosecute a search for the overdue steamer.
