

BAKER CITY WOMAN ENDS HER LIFE AT SANATORIUM

Portland, Ore., March 10.—Mrs. J. F. Ferguson, of Baker City, hanged herself this evening to a hinge of the door of her room at Mount Tabor Nervous sanitarium. Mrs. Ferguson was

brought here about two months ago to undergo treatment, and of late she has improved rapidly. At no time had she shown any suicidal inclination. Her body will probably be taken to Baker City for burial.

TOOK WRONG BOTTLE.

Young Albany Girl Has Narrow Escape From Death by Poisoning.

Albany, Ore., March 10.—Margaret Hays, the 8-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. M. F. Hays, of this city, had a narrow escape from death by poisoning yesterday. She has had a very severe cold and in attempting to take medicine, accidentally got a bottle of acetonite. She swallowed a teaspoonful of the liniment and then going to her mother asked her what had been put in her medicine. Her mother at once learned from what bottle she had secured the supposed medicine and immediately telephoned for a physician. Dr. W. Trimble arrived five minutes later and found the girl already black in the face, suffering from the effects of the poison. It was with difficulty that her life was saved.

Hard to Deliver News.

Chicago, March 10.—An indication of the storm's havoc is given in the extraordinary expedients to which resort was necessary in supplying news to California papers, news from San Francisco, intended for papers in Los Angeles, in the southern part of the state, could only reach their destination by a long, circuitous route via Chicago. Similarly news from Los Angeles intended for San Francisco traveled thousands of miles, across the continent and back again, to find a possible ingress.

DOES MUCH SHIPPING.

Palouse, on the Spokane-Lewiston Branch, Distributes Supplies.

Palouse, Wash., March 10.—Palouse City is without doubt the most important station on the line of the Spokane-Lewiston branch of the Northern Pacific. Palouse ships cargoes of wheat shiploads of oats, quantities of oats and many carloads of live stock. In addition it also ships lumber by carloads nearly every day in the year, and the station receipts are astonishingly large.

The certified report to the inquiring superintendent shows that during the past six months the railroad station receipts have gained over those of the previous six months \$12,000 or \$2000 a month. Only last Wednesday 14 full cars were billed out of here, four of lumber, four of hay, three of wheat and three of oats. The railroad is preparing to accommodate the trade by building a 50-foot extension to the depot. For this purpose much of the lumber is on the ground.

SAYS HE FOUND BAG.

John McCarthy, Arrested at Cornelius, May Be Man Who Robbed Saloon.

Hillsboro, Ore., March 10.—John McCarthy was yesterday arrested at Cornelius by Constable Bunning on a charge of drunkenness, and upon being searched was found to be in possession of a portion of the canvas bag taken from the nickel-in-the-slot machine in the saloon of C. Peters, at Cornelius. Early yesterday morning some one entered the saloon and breaking into the machine cut the canvas sack and took about \$4 in nickels. As soon as the sack was found on McCarthy he was brought to Hillsboro and arraigned before Justice Bagley on a charge of larceny in a store. He was committed to jail in default of \$1000 bonds.

The justice recognized McCarthy as an old offender, for the records here show that on January 7, McCarthy and two companions were sentenced to 10 days on the streets for vagrancy. Two saloons in Hillsboro have recently been entered in the same manner and it is thought that McCarthy is guilty of the crime charged there is reason to believe he and his companions entered the saloons here.

MASTER OF PROFANITY.

Tramp Arrested at Albany Sentenced to Ten Days' Confinement.

Albany, Ore., March 10.—The most accomplished man in the use of profanity who ever visited Albany is now in the city jail. He was begging at different houses in the eastern part of the city Monday and swore violently at those who refused to supply his demands. One prominent citizen whom he abused with outrageous language was forced to drive him from his premises with a club.

who reported his begging methods. Chief of Police McClain locked him up. He swore continually, and the officer says he is the worst user of profanity he has ever encountered. Every few minutes he "breaks out" and emits several hair-splitting oaths. His loud swearing often attracts crowds around the city jail, and everyone pronounces him a master of the use of profanity.

He was taken before City Recorder Van Winkle yesterday and was sentenced to ten days' confinement on bread and water for begging on the streets.
