BUTTONS FROM POTATOES.

A large number of the buttons now in use, purporting to be made out of bone or ivory, are in reality made out of the common potato, which, when treated with certain acids, becomes as hard as stone. This quality of the potato adapts it to button-making, and a very good grade of buttons is now made from the well-known tuber. The potato button cannot be distinguished from others save by a careful examination and even then only by an expert, since they are colored to suit the goods on which they are to be used, and are every whit as good looking as a button of bone or ivory.—Chicago Journal.
