

MEANS THROUGH LINE.

Compromise Between Bradford and Morgan Benefits Wisconsin Line.

CHICAGO, Feb. 28.—A dispatch to the Tribune from Milwaukee says:

The compromise yesterday of a legal battle between J. P. Morgan and W. A. Bradford of Cincinnati, over the Great Central System dissolution means that the Wisconsin Central road will have a through line from St. Paul and Duluth to Cincinnati via Chicago.

The agreement gives Bradford control of the old road, the Chicago Cincinnati & Louisville. This makes it possible to get entrance to Chicago Wisconsin Central connect with the enters Chicago over the Illinois Central tracks, but the plan to have the Pere Marquette receivership, which in Chicago, Cincinnati and Louisville at Chicago blocked by the Pere Marquette receivership which involved the Chicago, Cincinnati and Louisville. Bradford, before the beginning of this receivership, nearly had effected a deal by which he would enter Chicago over the Illinois Central tracks. This arrangement still is possible, as it is only necessary to build a few miles of track in northern Indiana. Bradford, with other directors of the Chicago, Cincinnati & Louisville owns the Wisconsin Central.

It was declared at the time of the purchase of the Wisconsin Central that its identity would be maintained, but that the operation of the roads might be from joint offices in Milwaukee.

Bradford, who was in New York yesterday, in conference with Morgan, has stated altho that all that prevented a junction of the two roads at the Illinois Central terminals in Chicago was the great Central receivership. Vice-President Starr said no word of compromise had reached him.
