GENERAL CAMPAIGN

Suggested that Real War be Made on the Land-Lubber Rats.

In connection with the fumigation of vessels to kill the rats as a precaution against the bubonic plague Dr. John F. Holt, of the Public Health and Marine Service of the United States, has suggested that general crusade against rats be made not only in this city but in all seaport towns. He states that rats are especially malignant in spreading all diseases and that Astoria is particularly infested with them. The only other city to realize this on the coast is Seattle and recently the public spirited men arranged for a rat killing day and all the brokers and business men along the waterfront got out and worked like fiends to rid the city and docks of rats.

Just what method would be used in getting rid of these animals is not stated but these are means of killing them. The cats in Astoria are not very sporty as there is enough for them to eat without hunting for a rat. But if there was some good breed of hunting cat introduced or if all the felines were starved and the rat terriers were given a commission the rodents would soon have to seek other territory.

In speaking of the local situation in regard to the recent orders regarding vessels to be inspected and fumigated Dr. Holt said: "Everything is progres-

sing smoothly and the officers fumigating vessels as fast as possible. We are treating the vessels and saving as much time to their captains and owners as possible and that will be our constant care. The detail of the plan is working to perfection."


