Daughter of Iron Manufacturer to Run a Farm.
CHICAGO, Dec. 10.—The announcement that of Mary Josephine Crane, daughter of the iron manufacturer, Chas. R. Crane, intends to become a farmer, is received with much interest by her relatives and intimate friends in Chicago. Miss Crane, who is 20 years old, is about to finish a three years course in agriculture in the University of Wisconsin at Madison, which she has attended three years. Her proficiency as a student has attracted favorable attention from the members of the University faculty and students, more particularly because Miss Crane has been deaf and dumb from birth. Miss Crane is a lover of athletics and has attended all the big football games at Madison this season. Miss Camp who acts an interpreter when necessary, accompanies Miss Crane into the class rooms and takes notes for her, although the latter can understand almost every word of a speaker by watching the motion of the mouth. She attends examinations alone, and has not yet failed to pass with high grade. She has made a special study of how to diet sheep and care for their wool. Among other accomplishments, Miss Crane is a horsewoman of grace and daring. She also has studied art with both brush and pen. Recently Miss Crane's father gave her a farm, near the Crane summer home near Lake Geneva. She intends personally to direct the work there next summer.
