

7. That on or about the 5th day of March, 1909, Officer Linville attempted to intimidate me and made threats of doing me great bodily harm...

8. That in 1907, when Stephenson was arrested upon complaint filed by P. M. Ellefson, for conducting a Dance Hall in the City of Astoria...

9. That according to his own testimony given under oath, before the investigating committee of the Common Council in 1908, the record of which is on file with the Auditor and Police Judge of the City of Astoria...
