WESLEY COLLEGE CAMPAIGN PROGRESSES

Local Organizations Forming—Explanation is Given for Need for Endowment.

Wesley College is affiliated with the University of North Dakota at Grand Forks. It is a church college adapted to provide the means of religious education at the state university.

The instruction courses offered in Wesley College are placed alongside those offered by the University, and are alike open to students on precisely the same conditions.

There is no organic union. The university is supported by state funds administered through a board of regents.

The vacant place of religious education at the state universities, normal schools and agricultural colleges is within the appointed province of the church as truly as the campus of the church college.

Therefore comes about that each professor is a teacher of his specialty for all university students, and in faculty councils he is recognized interpreter of the cause he represents.

It is clear that a university college serves in two capacities: it provides a portion of the instruction offered to university students in common, and is the appointed means of special training within its academic purpose.

All students may do some work in biology, but prospective medical students will do more; they will specialize in that department.

If religious culture is to be included in the general university education the affiliated church college is the academic means.
