

"LITTLE OLD FORDS" ARE "RAMBLING RIGHT ALONG" AT ANNUAL PICNIC TODAY

Third Annual Festival Under Way This Afternoon at Lincoln Park; With Many Machines and Large Number of Owners Present at Unique Affair.

Grand Forks is the Mecca for owners of Ford automobiles today. Hundreds of them are in town, each group riding in its Ford, and proud of the fact. All are making merry at the picnic arranged for their benefit by the Moore Automobile company of Grand Forks, and being held in Lincoln Park this afternoon.

From every part of Grand Forks county they have come, and there are representatives from the entire eastern half of North Dakota and a large number from neighboring Minnesota counties. Among the towns represented are: Inkster, Larimore, Northwood, Thompson, Reynolds, Manvel, Gilby, Park River, Neche, Minto, East Grand Forks, and Crookston.

This remarkable record has been made in spite of the fact that the picnic day has every year threatened rain. On the two previous occasions, the picnic has nevertheless been held on the day originally scheduled. It has occurred on June 30th each year previously, but this year it was postponed to July 10. Even postponement has not altered the determination of the hundreds of Ford enthusiasts who today are in attendance.

The parade started at Lincoln park, proceeded up Vernon and Reeves avenues, then struck Belmont avenue and proceeded to Third street, passing the length of this street and then turning into Riverside park. The party then passed through the city down Fourth street and back to the park.

At the park, lunch baskets soon made their appearance, and there was a stage of applicants at the lemonade and ice cream counters where these refreshments were furnished free of charge to the great crowd.

At the time for which this picnic had been scheduled originally, there were a large number of out-of-town parties who arrived in this city in preparation for the affair but who were disappointed because of the inclemency of the weather.

FORD NOTES

The Buxton band arrived on the scene early this morning and commenced a lively campaign to stir up the city. Concerts were given on the corners of the downtown district and later during the parade, several selections were played. The Buxton organization is comprised of 25 members and is classed as one of the best musical organizations in this section of the state.
