BLACKLISTING AMERICAN FIRMS

The American government is investigating the blacklisting of a number of American firms by the governments of the entente allies under orders in council and similar official pronouncements by these governments.

The orders under which these blacklists have been, or are being prepared, are in pursuance of plans of the allied governments to reinforce their military operations against the central empires by such economic pressure as they are able to bring to bear.

Heretofore business relations growing out of the war have been left largely to the discretion of individuals, subject to such regulations as each government, acting separately, saw fit to impose.

It is obviously to the interest of all the nations at war, not only to destroy the armies and occupy the territory of their enemies, but to hamper their enemies as much as possible in their industrial and commercial operations.

At the present time the presence of rust is not general, nor has it affected the crop materially in any locality. Whether or not damage will be done no man living can say, and more than any man can know in advance in any year what will happen to a crop within the next week.

If the weather from now until harvest is favorable for the propagation of rust, some damage will be done, how much no one knows. If it is not there will be no rust damage. If it were possible to know just what the weather will be it would be possible to make a reasonably accurate forecast of the rust conditions.
