GARDENS SHOW RESULTS AFTER MUCH LABOR

The Demonstration Farm in Charge of Prof. Schlenvogt Attracts Attention.

Many Children Actively Engaged in Farm Labors Under Auspices of School.

The Grand Forks demonstration farm, which is affiliated with the agricultural department of the city schools, and operated under the direction of Prof. H. Schlenvogt, is now credited with being one of the neatest appearing and cleanest garden districts in this section of the state.

Take Up Concrete Work. Not only have the students devoted their time to the gardens, but have also taken up concrete work.

Visit Farms. Visits have been made to some of the most modern farms in this section of the county in order to study the methods that have been adopted to carry on the industry on a scientific basis.

More trips will be made in the near future during which the judging of live stock and other interesting farm features will be included.

To Have Seed Corn. The members of the class now believe that they have in a unusually large amount of selected seed corn and pure marquis wheat this fall.

Garden Work Excellent. The garden work is in charge of Miss R. A. Haterall and has been carried out on more extensive scale than in any previous year.

Crops Are Fine. The crops are in the best possible condition. The corn is now bearing tassels and stands nearly eight feet high.

The growing of alfalfa has also been given considerable attention by Prof. Schlenvogt and his assistants.
