WANT TO RECONSIDER SALE OF ISLANDS Copenhagen, Sept. 7.—(Via London).—Representatives of the four political parties in the Danish parliament met yesterday and the conservatives propose that simultaneously with the formation of a coalition cabinet a committee of thirty members be appointed to reconsider the sale of the Danish West Indies to the United States. The conservatives proposed further that the committee should make a report and the convention with the United States then should be submitted to a plebiscite under the new constitution. The proposals also provided that if the plebiscite showed that less than half the electors are against the sale treaty it shall be resubmitted to the Danish people.
