GERMAN SUBS RAID CHANNEL

British Admiralty Gives Out Losses Only When Commons Demands. London, Nov. 1.-The loss of six drift net boats in addition to the sinking of the transport Queen and the torpedo boat destroyer Flirt in the recent raid by German submarines in the English channel was admitted by A. J. Balfour, first lord of the admiralty, in the house of commons today.

In answering questions concerning the raid on the channel transport service, the first lord said that while the raiders had all the advantages in choosing the moment for attack, in this case it certainly failed.

The only cross-channel steamer to be attacked, Mr. Balfour said, was the empty passenger vessel Queen and the world would have been glad, he added, if the captain realized that the steamer would float six hours after the attack.

The torpedo boat destroyer Flirt, he said, was surprised in the darkness by German destroyers which fired on her at close range and sank her. The destroyer Nubian, torpedoed while attacking the German squadron, could have been brought to harbor, the first lord asserted, but for the gallant deed that the Nubian can be salvaged.
