### WM. FISHMAN GIVEN PARDON

#### Local Man, Sentenced to Three Years, Serves Less Than Month.

The Herald late this afternoon received word to the effect that the sentence of Jess Hillsapock, who was given one year, was commuted to expire on August 1. Clifford Wrentz, who was sentenced to five years, applied for a pardon, but his application was denied.

he applied for a pardon. Today he was pardoned by the board. The following dispatch from the Bismarck correspondent of The Herald gives the results of the pardon board's actions today:

Bismarck, N. D., June 5.—Nine pardons were granted by the state board of pardons in their session today. They were: Nick Chermag, entered prison Feb. 18, 1916, 15 to 25 years, murder, Eddy county; Bernard L. Laux, entered prison Jan. 11, 1922, two years, embezzlement, Benson county; Howard A. Loo, entered prison on Feb. 5, 1921, two years, burglary, Grand Forks; Angell Lund, entered prison Nov. 27, 1921, two years, grand larceny, Ransom county; M. T. Qilo, entered prison Oct. 17, 1921, carried concealed weapons, Grand Forks; Allen Weitala, entered prison Nov. 28, 1921, 14 months, rape, Dickey county; William Fishman, entered prison Jan. 28, 1922, one to three years, bootlegging, Grand Forks; John Mueller, entered prison July 30, 1916, thirty years, murder, second degree, Stutsman county.

A number of commutations also were granted and the list has not yet been announced.

### ROTARY CAMP IS MADE READY

#### Rotarians Paint Buildings and Erect New Administration House.

Members of the Grand Forks Rotary club were at Camp Rotary, Union Lake, Saturday and Sunday to place the camp in readiness for the first of the Boy Scout encampments. The camp will be opened on June 10, when the T. M. C. A. boys will occupy the place for a period of ten days. The camp will be opened for ten-day periods from that date until September 1.

The Rotarians painted all the camp buildings, such as the bunk houses and the mess hall. A new administration building was erected. This will be occupied by the Boy Scout leader, and also will be used for the scout library.

### BURTNESS IS IN THE CITY

#### First District Congressman Arrives Here to Attend to Business Matters.

Congressman O. B. Burtness, Republican nominee for re-election, arrived in Grand Forks last night to attend to business matters. Mrs. Burtness accompanied him as far as Detroit, Minn., where she is visiting her parents. She will come to Grand Forks in a short time.

Mr. Burtness said today that the length of his stay in Grand Forks depended upon the progress the senate makes with the tariff and bonus bills. The house has practically completed its work, and will begin three-day recesses to give the senate an opportunity to catch up with its labors. Indications are that the tariff and bonus bills will not be passed for several weeks.

### OLD FIRE FESTIVAL WILL BE REVIVED IN FARGO CELEBRATION

Fargo, N. D., June 5.—Twenty-five of the crack fire fighters of the old volunteer departments, who held international speed records, will dash down Broadway, laying hose and starting water playing on approximately the same spot that the fire of 1893 started, as a feature of the Legion Fire Festival Tuesday, the 34th anniversary of the fire that wiped out practically the entire business district. Old hose reels have been resurrected, and the apparatus of thirty years ago will be used in the run, even to the flashy uniforms.
