Sacramento, Nov. 14.—The Convention met at 10 A. M. Ayers, by request of the Grand Lodge of Good Templars, presented a mammoth petition in favor of the local option clause in the Constitution.

Caples presented a minority report from the Committee on Suffrage against the proposal to permit the Legislature to extend the franchise to women.

The Convention went into Committee of the Whole on the article on incorporation, the pending question being an amendment to section three, making direct and indirect trustees responsible for embezzlement and misappropriation of funds.

Edgerton opposed the amendment, stating that under no civilization, except the Chinese, was a man made responsible for acts of his fellows.

Moreland, of Sonoma, supported the proposition, followed by Freud, taking the same side.

Belcher said he should oppose any such proposition now and at all times.

Smith, of Kern, supported Terry's proposition on the ground that, if it was a mistake, it was on the side of the people.

Reynolds, of San Francisco, also advocated the same in a 30-minute speech.

Eagan, of Anaheim, opposed the amendment, saying that it would do lasting wrong. "Place such a provision in the Constitution," he said, "and only irresponsible persons would accept the office of trustee."

Lindley said he should vote for the amendment because of the bad management that had occurred in savings banks.

At 12 o'clock the committee reported progress, and the customary recess was taken.
