The San Francisco Grand Jury at Work—Other Notes.

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 21.—The grand jury were to-day investigating charges preferred by Denis Kearney against District Attorney Murphy, City and County Attorney Burnett and Auditor Maynard in connection with the affairs of the late Alexander Austin.

August E. Gass, member of the County Committee of the anti-Kearney wing of the Workingmen's party, was before the Grand Jury to-day, he having prepared charges of perjury against Kearney, based on the latter's testimony at the trial of charges preferred against Sergeant Harmon of the police force in connection with the attack of the police on the crowd at the Horticultural Hall meeting.

The Convention.

SACRAMENTO, Dec. 24th.—The Convention met, ninety-three members present. Dudley offered an amendment concerning revenue and taxation, which was referred to the Committee of the Whole.

It provides that all property, the income from which is not taxed, excluding growing crops, and private property exempt from taxes under the laws of the United States or any municipality thereof, and property used exclusively for charitable purposes not exceeding one thousand dollars, shall be taxed in proportion to its value.

Exemptions from ad valorem tax are as follows: Notes, mortgages and securities of any kind, the income from which is taxed, and all property owned by and necessarily used by corporations in producing incomes which are taxed.

On motion of Edgerton the Convention went into Committee of the Whole on the article relating to the right of suffrage for adjournment until Thursday afternoon was adopted.

The Convention proceeded to the consideration of the article on revenue and taxation in Committee of the Whole, but as no disposition was manifested to consider the article a quorum failing to vote on amendments, Estee, of San Francisco, moved that the Committee rise. Carried.

Haskell submitted a minority report from the Committee on Education. On motion of Edgerton the Convention went into Committee of the Whole on the article relating to the right of suffrage for adjournment until Thursday afternoon was adopted.
