

A CHINESE LOTHARIO.

A Moon-eyed Loper Charged with Stealing the English Wife of Another Chinaman.

John Dick Sing, the Chinaman, who, as told in yesterday's Star, is in Ludlow Street Jail, charged with eloping with Charles Hee Sing's English wife, was visited by a reporter yesterday. John, who is known as John Dixon, parts his hair in the middle and wears a mustache. He denied Hee Sing's allegation, and said he, "Nevell wakkee" will win his wife. Charles Hee Sing, he added, was a bad man. He went to Hee Sing's boarding house because he had little money and wished to live "cheap."

Late one night when he arrived home he found Mr. and Mrs. Hee Sing and Mrs. Yung, "an Hish lady, wife of wash-Chinaman," sitting in the parlor, and he sobly sent out for a pint of beer. Mrs. Hee Sing did not drink, but Mrs. Yung was moaning with John, and asked him to "sitte neala" her, and asked his name. Mrs. Hee Sing, it appears, was in a sarcastic mood, and told Mrs. Yung that John had the name of a woman, and that they were brothers. John was equally pungent, and retorted that, supposing Hee Sing was a "darkey" and named William, and a white man was also named William, that he did not know them "brothers."

John returned to the Navy Yard and his post in the cook's galley of the frigate Constellation. On Monday afternoon Mrs. Hee Sing and Mrs. Yung called on him, and the former told him that she had left her husband and found John a better boarding place. But John, who, to credit his story, is a Mongolian Joseph, professed himself contented with his Brooklyn boarding house, and said he wished to remain single, as he had hardly enough to keep himself. On the next day Mrs. Hee Sing came again, and though she drank beer with her, he did not, he says, accompany her. It was when he returned to Hee Sing's house for his trunk that Charles set the minions of the law after him. John patiently conveyed his trunk by express, with tears in his eyes: "I nebbe had anything do wid wim, and no lun way wid nodder man's wife. When I gettee out I be shamee lookee anybody in de eye."

It is reported that the Chinese are about to establish a steamship line of their own, and that their chief employment will be to transport coolies to the Sandwich Islands and to the United States. Of course it is vehemently asserted that the Chinese Government will prevent the large emigration which this enterprise seems to render possible, but the newspapers of Shanghai and Hong Kong profess to be certain that the new line will be chiefly used in the coolie traffic. The whole scheme will doubtless be conducted with the usual shrewdness and cunning of Chinese traders and if the coolie traffic promises to be the most profitable, the coolie trade will be well for the United States Government to protect the Pacific Coast from any further influx of the Mongolian race.—San Jose Mercury.
