LATE TELEGRAMS. SPECIAL TO THE HERALD. Edmunds' Envoys. SAN FRANCISCO, May 12.—Senator Edmunds, being a Vermont, attended the regular monthly meeting last evening of the Native Sons of Vermont. The Senator was wily checked. He said: "I have often been asked if Vermont is proud of the fact as I am now. Until very recently I had never crossed the wide land that is now Vermont. I had only seen it in the papers and in the lives of my forefathers. When I came to this young State, younger than any other in the Union, to the honor to say we were boys together. I was astonished at this exalted land. Here is a city of half a century standing, yet rivaling the old cities of the East in splendor, magnificence and civilization—rivaling, I say, cities of a thousand years. It is a city of the young, much younger, than most of us here present."

Trunk Factory Fire—Opium Den. SAN FRANCISCO, May 12.—Black & Co.'s trunk factory was destroyed by fire this morning. It was situated on the corner of Fourth and Brannan streets. The fire was caused by the engineer accidentally burning a pile of shavings. Loss \$25,000.

Ab Lung, the keeper of an opium den, and two white visitors, were arrested and convicted before Judge Webb this morning. In passing sentence the Court spoke emphatically of the evils of opium smoking, and announced his intention to do his utmost to break it up by severe punishment. He sentenced Ab Lung to three months imprisonment in the House of Correction, and the two men, whom the Judge held to be equally blame, were awarded the same punishment.

Rescue He is a Democrat. SAN FRANCISCO, May 12.—W. A. Walker, appointed by the Memorial Committee, G. A. R., Grand Marshal for Memorial Day, about two months ago, was this evening asked to resign by a vote of eight to four. It is said that the Committee were approached by a number of members of the G. A. R., who refused to march on Memorial Day because Walker is a Democrat. They also assailed his standing as a man, and his fitness for the place, but nothing of this could be proven. Comrade Stone, one of the committee, offered to go before any select committee and prove that politics was at the bottom of the affair. No definite action was taken, as Walker did not send in his resignation.

Prison Directors—Ball Terrible. SAN FRANCISCO, May 12.—A citation has been served on the State Prison Directors to answer charges preferred against them for misconduct in office. The investigation is to take place June 14th at Sacramento.

The Kennel Club met last night at the Occidental Hotel to take measures to find out, and arrest the man who poisoned the bull terriers at the beach show.

The Loss. SAN FRANCISCO, May 12.—Loss by the fire this morning at the trunk factory is now estimated at \$60,000.

Fourth Battalion Recampment. SACRAMENTO, May 11.—The Fourth Battalion, N. G. C., have decided to have an encampment, beginning August 1st. The place is not determined. Woodland citizens offer \$1,000 to have it there. Sacramento is also a favorite with some of the officers.

Earthquake—Riot. VICTORIA, B. C., May 12.—Last night several shocks of earthquakes were felt here. The movement was from north to south.

Chinese laborers on the railway at Lyton, beat their foreman and three other men with shovels last night. An armed band of white burrows, in Chinese camp, beat and shot the occupants, killing one man and injuring several. The white laborers along the railroad have organized to resist the encroachments of Chinese.

The Kentucky Home. CINCINNATI, May 12.—The Times Star, of Harrodsburg, Ky., says: In the trial of Phil B. Thompson for the murder of Walter H. Davis, the Judge ruled that the witness, Jno. B. Thompson, could not state that he heard from Mrs. Thompson, but could tell what information he gave to defendant. The witness said Mrs. Thompson, wife of defendant, was 42 years of age and Davis only 28. During the past two years Mrs. Thompson was often beset with fits in this condition which is not common to the age of Harrodsburg. The cross-examination was much protracted with the effort to break down the defense suggested by D. W. Voorhees of the terrible agitation of Phil B. Thompson, just before the killing. But the fact was elicited that after Thompson gave himself up he wrote out his own speech for the use of the reporters who telegraphed it. Voorhees and his associates are anxious to finish the testimony to-day.

Railroad Rates. NEW YORK, May 12.—Another meeting of general passenger agents of railroads in the joint executive commission and representatives of roads west of Chicago and St. Louis was held to-day. The subject of rate cutting in San Francisco by agents of Eastern lines and the appointment of arbitrators to settle differences was discussed at length. The action taken will be to be settled before the meeting to-day. Adjourned.

Uncle Sam's Pocket Money. WASHINGTON, May 12.—A statement of the United States Treasurer shows gold, silver and United States notes in the Treasury to-day as follows: Gold coin and bullion \$191,851,250; silver coin and bullion \$101,814,287; fractional silver coin \$28,161,460; United States notes \$40,478,485; total \$370,505,877. Certificates outstanding represent gold, \$68,148,770; silver, \$72,197,741; currency, \$1,385,000.

The Weed Cut Off. PETERSBURG, Va., May 12.—Intelligence is received from different sections of Virginia to the effect that great damage is being done to the young tobacco plants by the tobacco fly, and in many instances farmers have had all their plants destroyed. Planters feel much discouraged.

Delaware's Institution. NEW CASTLE, Dela., May 12.—Nine culprits were whipped at the post this morning for various offenses.

Chicago, May 12.—Deputy U. S. Marshal Compton, of Utah, arrived in Chicago this morning from Caro, Mich., on route for Salt Lake City, having in charge Alexander S. Hill, who is wanted at the Mormon city to answer the charge of embezzling \$9,300 from his wife, Lucy Hill. Compton will arrive in Salt Lake next Wednesday. Hill is a gentle and his wife is said to be of the Mormon persuasion. The case has created a good deal of excitement in Brigham Young's territory, and the return of the prisoner is looked forward to with considerable interest.

Solid Financial Situation. NEW YORK, May 12.—The bank statement shows in the reserve fund an increase of \$3,309,700. Banks now hold \$3,008,925 in excess of legal requirements.

The Exhibition Opened. LONDON, May 12.—The International Fisheries Exhibition was opened to-day with great festivity by the Prince of Wales. The ceremonies of the occasion were in accordance with the programme heretofore announced. The Prince of Wales, who had taken in regard to the exhibition the role of a dignitary, and conveyed Her Majesty's congratulations to all countries participating in the display and to the proprietors for their untiring exertions in the work of insuring the success of the exhibition.

The Pope on Ireland. ROME, May 12.—Archbishop Croke, Dublin, received an audience by the Pope to-day. The Pope informed the Archbishop of certain grave resolutions which he had taken in regard to the agitation in Ireland, especially one condemning the clergy for promoting the Parnell fund. It is believed these resolutions will shortly be sent to the Irish Episcopate.

Probably a Lunatic. DUBLIN, May 12.—The man Kinsella, who made a voluntary confession to the police that he was concerned in the murder of Lord Leitrim, was again arraigned to-day. His story is not believed as it is thought he is a lunatic. The judge was about to discharge Kinsella when the latter said he was afraid he would be shot if he was released, he was therefore remanded to prison.

So Much The Worse For Some Liberals. LONDON, May 12.—It is stated that a large proportion of abstentions on voting during the recent division in the Commons has been deliberate, and that there is a growing disposition among Liberals to support the government.

China, Japan and Corea. LONDON, May 12.—The Pall Mall Gazette says the Japanese Government has proposed to China that they establish a joint protectorate over Corea. China, however, is not inclined to accept the proposition.

Orient Opposing France. LONDON, May 12.—It is understood that the foreign office has received news to the effect that China intends to oppose the plans of France in regard to the establishment of a French protectorate in Tonkin.

The People Lose a Friend. ROME, May 12.—Archbishop Croke has promised the Pope that he will in future conform to the attitude of Cardinal McCabe with regard to Irish affairs.
