New York, Nov. 26.—A meeting of the joint executive committee of the New York Associated Press and the Western Association of Presses called in New York yesterday.

William N. Hoar, of the Louisville Courier-Journal, after a thorough investigation of the work, including a review of instructions to correspondents, candidates, complaints from both Democratic and Republican sources, and a list of returns received by telegraph.

W. S. Hoar, of the Louisville Courier-Journal, and Richard Smith, of the Cincinnati Enquirer, were appointed a sub-committee to summarize the conditions resulting from the investigation.

They presented the following report, which was unanimously adopted by the committee.

The joint executive committee of the Associated Press and the Western Association of Presses did not deem it advisable during a sharply contested campaign to take any action which would be interpreted as an endorsement of any candidate.
