The Cause of Booms. Divers newspapers in all parts of the United States are discussing the fact that a great deal of capital is now seeking investment in real estate, and thus creating what are termed "booms," in many cities throughout the land.

Streets of ample width to accommodate the business and population of the city are vital to its proper growth. Are there enough wide streets for a large city in this municipality at present?

It is hardly right to call this movement in financial circles a boom, or an excitement. There has not been so much of the speculative element in the situation as might appear at first blush.

The influx of new people from abroad, and the national increase of native population, presses immigration into new portions of the natural domain, and the concomitant of this movement is the building of lines of railroads to the new homes of the settlers.

The Russian government first took in hand seriously the abolition of this wild expense, owing to its being perpetually more or less submerged and covered with a jungle growth of forest preventing not only communication between the Russian districts on either side, but also between Russia and Austria-Germany.
