Stock Exchange Review.

New York, June 5.—While movements in the stock market were erratic again today, there was, on the whole, a steady feeling, and quotations generally show net gains. Notwithstanding numerous failures reported from Chicago and the strained financial conditions at the west, there is no particular pressure to sell here except from bear sources.
