Stock Exchange Review.

New York, Sept. 19.—The course of speculation on the stock exchange today was in the nature of a surprise, even to the very persons who themselves manipulated the market. Despite the weakness of American securities in London, prices here at the opening were generally higher and a firm tone prevailed. The boom made a vigorous raid and everything went up, but soon recovered. The final sales were generally at or within a fraction of the highest prices of the day, and the tone of the dealings was decidedly strong.
